To our valued customers:

Please be advised that supply conditions have quickly deteriorated over the past two weeks as we enter the final stages of the Mexican season. Growers are actively withholding harvests and field prices are surging at an extremely fast pace as packers compete for the limited supply of remaining fruit.

Despite our efforts to mitigate the impact of these market conditions, available supply is no longer sufficient to meet U.S. demand. As a result, and due to circumstances beyond our control, we will be declaring *Force Majeure* under the following conditions:

- Pricing will be market-based for orders shipping beginning Tuesday, May 26<sup>th</sup>
- All orders will be subject to availability based on current inventory
- Alternative COO's may be utilized as supply permits (California/Peru/Colombia)

We anticipate this supply shortage to remain in place for the next two months given the current crop outlook. We will communicate with you as the situation develops and provide updated information you can share with your teams and customers. We appreciate your understanding and partnership during this temporary disruption. Please do not hesitate to reach out if you have any questions.
